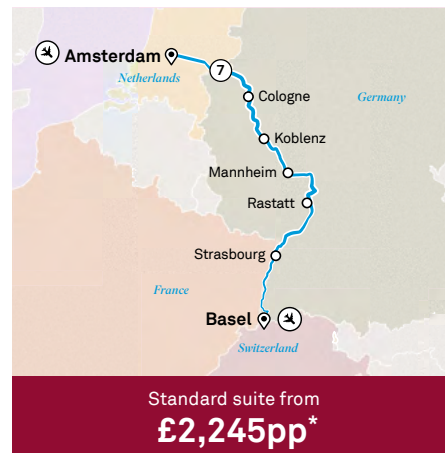

KWAZULU-NATAL

Having been to the Western Cape in South Africa a few times, I wanted to explore the country and visit a new area which led me to experiencing KwaZulu-Natal for my family holiday in the summer of 2024. WOW!

Rich in cultural heritage, KZN is a coastal province known for its beaches, mountains, battlefields, safari game reserves, wetlands and even better its malaria free! You have the Indian Ocean to the east and the Drakensberg mountains to the west and it is also an all-year-round destination.

We started in Cape Town for a few nights and then took the 2-hour flight to Durban. We collected our hire car and headed up the coastal route to Sala Beach House. It is an intimate boutique hotel in the most stunning location at Thompson Bay.

Views are amazing, coastline stunning and the sound of the Indian Ocean is wonderful to listen to as you drift off to sleep. It has the feeling of being in a private home and the staff just cannot do enough for you.

We then headed into the Drakensberg mountains, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, where you can hike, take trails and enjoy the beauty of the mountains range.

Onwards to the Battlefields where we stayed at Fugitives Drift Lodge, located in 5000 acres of the Natural Heritage site, and owned by the Rattray family. The hotel offers breathtaking views out over Zululand and the Buffalo River. The Battlefields make for a once in a lifetime experience for the Anglo-Zulu war of 1879 and you will take part in the tours which brings the battles of Rorke's Drift and Isandlwana to life. I was totally drawn in by our wonderful guide and his outstanding storytelling. You must visit here when coming to KZN.

From here we then had 4 nights safari, split between Thanda Safari Lodge and Rhino Sands.

Thanda offers 9 suites designed to pay homage to the regions Zulu culture, where traditional homesteads were circular. This hotel had a more authentic feel and is located in the Private

Game Reserve. We experienced an evening with Zulu dancing and the game drives were fantastic as we had our own tracker.

Rhino Sands is a tented camp and located in the Manyoni Private Game reserve. This was a different experience to Thanda, with only 5 suites felt more intimate. It was good to have the contrast with both camps.

From there we drove back to Richards Bay airport for our flight to Johannesburg and we had a wonderful stay at the beautiful Fairlawns Boutique hotel, located in Sandton. The hotel is memorable for its amazing spa, beautiful gardens and its design and feel.

During our stay at Sala, we also had a trip to Umhlanga where you can take in the famous lighthouse located beside the Oyster Box hotel.

I was impressed by KZN, it is so diverse but incredibly authentic which we loved. The areas are quite far apart so a car is essential, although transfers or a driver can be arranged too. It is a wonderful family destination as there is something for everyone.

KZN is an outstanding part of Africa; it truly was a special trip for us all!

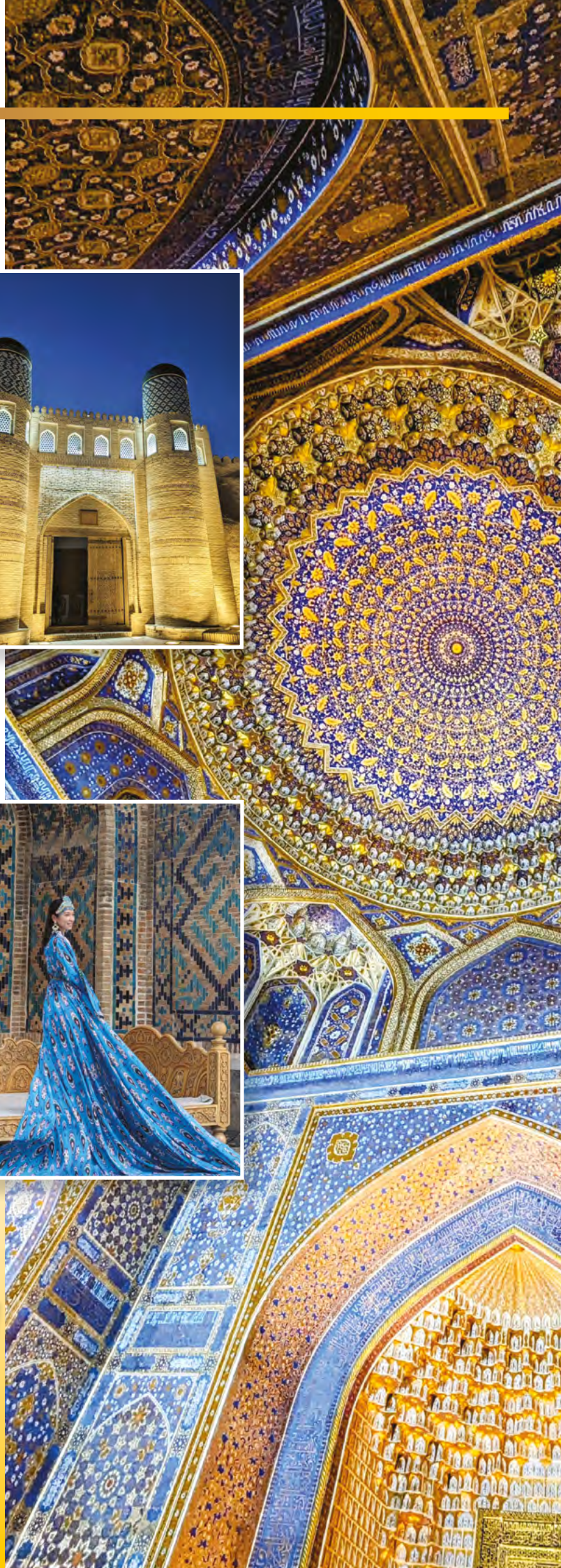

We waved goodbye to Bukhara as we boarded the Afrosiyob train to Samarkand, welcomed by our new guides who were excited to show us more of their beautiful country. In Samarkand, we embarked on a historical journey, discovering traditions and skills passed down through generations of the Uzbek people. Despite the historic attacks of Genghis Khan and the Mongol armies, the city managed to preserve and/or restore its beauty and its traditions. This too was shown in our next stop of Tashkent, the most modern of all our stops in Uzbekistan. A city bursting with tradition while welcoming more Western aspects.

Hotels are of a good standard from small boutique properties in great locations to more Western type hotels catering for all your needs. Train travel was very comfortable and we ate in some great restaurants and were invited into a local family's home where they happily served a delicious, traditional home cooked meal.

Uzbekistan is bursting with colour, pride and tradition. For anyone who needs to fulfil their desire to learn more about the history of Central Asia or even to feed their curiosity for this staggering country, the Uzbek people are ready and excited to welcome more travellers to their warm and loving home. 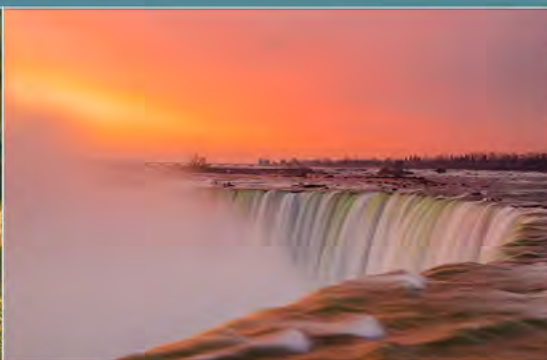

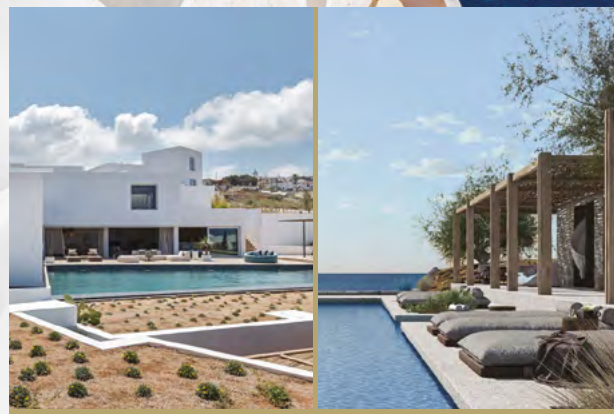

I was excited to get the chance to visit the iconic and picture-perfect island of Santorini, now available to travel from Edinburgh.

I stayed at the Andros Arcadia in Oia, a tranquil haven situated a few minutes' walk from the hustle and bustle of the Caldera. We enjoyed a lovely lunch in a traditional taverna (Pelekanos, which I would thoroughly recommend) with fabulous food and stunning views of the famous blue domes, we then had a wander round the pretty cobbled streets of this bustling Greek village, taking in the beauty of this volcanic island where whitewashed villages cling to towering cliffs.

A few calories were burnt off as we visited two of Andronis other properties Andronis Boutique and Andronis Suites. Both built clinging to the cliff with stunning views from every room.

After a few nights in the busier Santorini, we boarded the ferry for a 50-minute crossing to the island of Folegandros, a chance to sample the real off the beaten track Greece, it truly is one of the most stunning places I have visited. The island has 700 inhabitants, 200 churches and 18 beaches some only accessible by boat.
